Score and statement	Action
4	ACT NOW – Urgent – do something about the risks immediately. Requires immediate attention.
A: Acute	
3	Highest management decision is required urgently.
H: High	
2	Follow management instructions.
M: Moderate	
1	OK for now. Record and review if any equipment/ people/ materials/ work processes or procedures change.
L: Low
